Dales and Trails at Blaithwaite Farm

Giggleswick, Settle, North Yorkshire, BD24 0FE

Tucked away on a working farm in the picturesque village of Giggleswick, Dales and Trails offers a unique, exclusive-use camping experience – perfect for Indie travellers seeking privacy and adventure. Just outside the vibrant market town of Settle, and within easy reach of the Yorkshire Dales, Forest of Bowland and Lake District, it's an ideal base for road-trippers. When you stay, it's just you and the view – with access to a fully equipped kitchen, two private shower rooms, a cosy sheltered outdoor space, and a fire pit. The site is especially popular with outdoor lovers, cyclists, and motorcyclists thanks to its secure storage and optional guided tours around the Dales and beyond.

Craken House Farm Caravan and Camping Site

Middleham Road, Leyburn, North Yorkshire, DL8 5HF

Open March to November, Craken House Farm is a peaceful adults-only site just one mile from the market town of Leyburn. Set on a traditional Dales farm with panoramic views and no road noise, it's a tranquil base for exploring North Yorkshire. The site connects directly to local footpaths, making it easy to walk to Leyburn, Wensley and Middleham, or venture further afield. Facilities include separate male and female toilets, showers, a utility room with washing-up sinks, and a small communal fridge/freezer. A washer/dryer is also available.



Clarion Lodge Campsite

West Chevin Road, Menston, Ilkley, LS29 6BG

Clarion Lodge Campsite is a peaceful, family-friendly spot with ten hard-standing pitches and two tent areas, all offering optional electric hook-up. On site, you'll find well-maintained ladies and gents toilet and shower facilities, plus a communal log cabin with washing-up sinks. Set in beautiful countryside near Otley, it's ideal for walkers, climbers, and cyclists looking to explore Otley Chevin and the wider Yorkshire landscape. The nearby market town of Otley is packed with charm, known for its traditional pubs and annual events like the Otley Show, Carnival, and Folk Festival.



Ivy Bank Campsite

Galphay Road, Kirkby Malzeard, Ripon, North Yorkshire, HG4 3SS

Ivy Bank is a refreshingly relaxed, family-friendly campsite on the edge of the Yorkshire Dales and Nidderdale AONB – a great choice for Indie explorers looking for stunning views and a no-fuss atmosphere. Facilities include heated showers, a guest kitchen area with fridge and freezer, and plenty of thoughtful extras. The on-site café serves fresh breakfasts, coffee, and sweet treats, and there's a village pub, shop, butchers and chippy just a short walk away. Ivy Bank also caters for horse owners, with paddocks, exercise tracks and dedicated facilities. Fire pits and mobile hot tubs are available to hire, making it easy to add a little luxury to your off-grid adventure.

Hales Hill Park

Airfield Lane, Acaster Selby, York, YO23 7BW

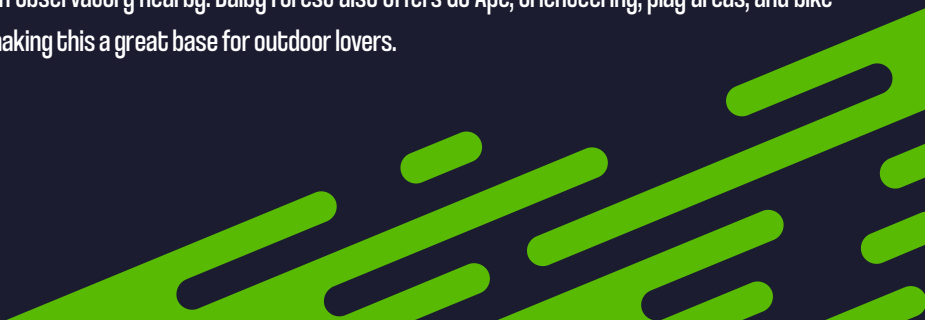
Just 6 miles from the centre of York, Hales Hill Park is a peaceful, family-run riverside retreat set on a 70-acre working farm. Open from April to October, the site welcomes campervans, tourers, and tents, with electric hookup on all pitches. The park offers two toilet and shower blocks (with disabled access), a pot washing area, a playground, and recently added Wi-Fi. The on-site clubhouse has river views and a well-stocked bar, while the surrounding area offers easy access to York's historic sights, Castle Howard, Eden Camp, and Flamingo Land. Dogs are warmly welcomed.



South Moor Farm

Langdale End, Scarborough, YO13 0LW

South Moor Farm offers a peaceful escape in a rural corner of Dalby Forest, perfect for both relaxed stays and adventure-filled breaks. Set on a working farm with cows, sheep, dogs and chickens, the site is surrounded by walking trails, mountain biking routes, and bridleways – including the Moors to Sea cycle route and the Tabular Hills Walk, which passes right by the farm. Well-behaved dogs are welcome, and horse riders can explore forestry tracks or make use of the on-site bridle path. Stargazers will appreciate the dark skies, ideal for telescopes, with an observatory nearby. Dalby Forest also offers Go Ape, orienteering, play areas, and bike hire, making this a great base for outdoor lovers.





Tip Top Campsite

Skandi Lodge, The Old Tip, Keighley Road, Silsden, BD20 0EH

Tip Top is a relaxed, riverside pop-up campsite tucked away in Silsden, West Yorkshire – perfectly placed at the gateway to the Yorkshire Dales. Surrounded by willow trees on a quiet smallholding, it's ideal for guests looking for a peaceful base with easy access to nature, local food spots, and the nearby train line to Skipton, Ilkley, and Leeds. The site offers a mix of grass pitches and glamping pods, along with a communal seating area, chimineas, and a welcoming on-site café serving fresh breakfasts, coffee, and cakes. Facilities include unisex showers, phone charging, and two EV points. Silsden's pubs, bistros and shops are within walking distance, while Haworth, Skipton, and Ilkley are a short drive or train ride away.

Wethercote Farm Campsite

Hambleton, Thirsk, North Yorkshire, YO7 2HW

Set on a family-run working farm with sweeping views of the Hambleton Hills and North York Moors, Wethercote Farm offers a peaceful, rural escape that's rich in local heritage. Just off the Cleveland Way walking route, it features basic grass pitches, some with electric hook-up, along with hot showers, toilets, washing-up facilities, fire pits, and drinking water taps. You'll be staying among fields of cattle, sheep, and wildlife, and may even recognise the farm from Channel 5's *The Yorkshire Vet*, where the family still features. With Thirsk, Helmsley, and the East Coast all within reach, it's an ideal base for walking, mountain biking, horse trekking or simply slowing down.



Wharfe Camp

Kettlewell, North Yorkshire, BD23 5HX

Wharfe Camp is a peaceful, adults-only retreat nestled on the edge of the picturesque village of Kettlewell in the heart of the Yorkshire Dales National Park. With just five tent pitches and one small campervan pitch, it's perfect for couples and solo travellers seeking a quiet stay in spectacular surroundings. The site is within walking distance of village pubs, a deli café, and a local shop. Walkers and cyclists are spoiled for choice with nearby access to the Dales Way, Great Whernside, and the iconic limestone landscapes of Wharfedale. Facilities include toilets, a hot shower, washing-up area, and a freezer for ice packs. With no pets, groups, or noise, Wharfe Camp offers a rare slice of calm in one of the Dales' most scenic corners.



Garth Farm Campsite

Hollym, East Yorkshire, HU19 2SJ

Tucked away on a quiet bridleway in the village of Hollym, Garth Farm is a peaceful, family-run site just two miles from the traditional seaside town of Withernsea. Surrounded by open fields and close to two hidden nature reserves, it's an ideal base for slow travel, walking and coastal exploring. The site welcomes campervans, caravans, and tents, with spacious pitches – each with its own water tap – and year-round availability depending on the weather. Facilities include toilets, showers, a fridge/freezer, and washing-up area. Dogs are welcome on leads, and firepits and BBQs are allowed. With a pub and café in walking distance, plus easy access to the beach, this tucked-away spot offers a laid-back countryside escape.

Riverside Glamping & Caravan Park

Mill Fold Way, Ripponden, HX6 4DJ

Set in a peaceful valley alongside the Ryburn River, Riverside offers spacious caravan pitches and cosy pods with electric hook-up, water, drains, heating, parking, fire pits, and picnic benches. Facilities include two unisex bathrooms with showers, washing-up areas, and waste disposal. The site is 10 minutes from the M62, between Leeds and Manchester, with easy access to local pubs, restaurants, a park, skatepark, tennis courts, and crown green bowling nearby. Walking and mountain biking routes are accessible directly from the site, including the Pennine Way and Hardcastle Craggs. Dog and family friendly.



Yapham Holds Farmhouse

Feoffee Lane, Pocklington, York YO42 1PF

Yapham Holds Farmhouse is a peaceful, adults-only glamping and camping site in East Yorkshire, surrounded by the gentle hills of the Yorkshire Wolds. With spacious grass pitches, clean modern facilities including underfloor-heated showers, and a well-equipped pot wash area with fridge, freezer, and microwave, it's a comfortable base for relaxed countryside stays. The nearby market town of Pocklington offers independent shops, pubs, cafés, and takeaways, while walkers and cyclists can enjoy direct access to routes like the Yorkshire Wolds Way and the Way of the Roses. Dogs are welcome, and secure bike storage is available on-site. York is just a short drive away, making this a convenient spot for rural breaks with the option to dip into the city.





Beech Tree Park

Huggin Carr Road, Hatfield, Doncaster, DN7 6BY

A peaceful adults-only site set on 17 rural acres, just 15 minutes from Doncaster and within an hour of York, the east coast, and the Peak District National Park. The site boasts a well-stocked fishing lake surrounded by woods and grassland, perfect for a serene day of fishing and relaxation. Modern, spotless amenities include a toilet and shower block exclusively for overnight guests, free Wi-Fi, and electric hook-ups. Located in Hatfield Woodhouse, Beech Tree Park offers easy access to main roads and motorways, with Doncaster nearby for shops, restaurants, and other urban conveniences.

St Helena's Caravan Park

Otley Old Road, Bramhope, LS18 5HZ

A family-run, adult-only site set within 45 acres of peaceful fields and woodlands in scenic Wharfedale. St Helena's is ideally located for exploring the Yorkshire Dales and nearby market towns including Otley, Ilkley, and Knaresborough, with Harrogate and Leeds just 20 minutes away. The site offers a choice of hardstanding, all-weather grass, and grass pitches with optional electric hook-ups. Facilities include toilet and shower blocks, laundry room, fresh water supply, grey water and chemical disposal points, and recycling bins. BBQ racks are provided for disposable barbecues to protect the grass, and children are welcome during the day.
